on behalf of their clients and in the best interest of children; and

WHEREAS: We recognize the important role of Guardians ad Litem for listening and advocating for children;

and

WHEREAS: We recognize the significant role judges plays in evaluating information and adhering to the

highest standards to keep children and their parents/legal guardians connected and to help

families heal; and

WHEREAS: We recognize the schoolteachers, cultural communities, and faith and neighborhood organizations

who care and support children and families through uneasy transitions; and

WHEREAS: We honor the resilience and wisdom of children and youth who experience foster care.
